

**By-Law No. 1694**  
**OF THE TOWN OF FORT MACLEOD**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Town of Fort Macleod, under the authority of By-law 1694, may set restrictions of water usage by Council resolution and since it is deemed in the Towns best interest to restrict water usage at certain times, hereby enacts the following:

**AND WHEREAS**, during the period of June 1<sup>st</sup> to October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, watering of outside lawns and gardens shall not be allowed between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day.

**THEREFORE**, watering of outside lawns and gardens shall be allowed only on the odd or even day of the month in accordance with the last number of a street address. (i.e) 529-28 Street would be allowed to water outside lawns or gardens on odd days of the month only. Odd numbered days would be those dates ending with 1-3-5-7-9. Even numbered days would be those dates ending with 2-4-6-8-0. There will be no watering of outside lawns and gardens on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of any month.

**OFFENCES, PENALTIES AND VIOLATION TAG PROCEDURE**

- 1) A person who contravenes any provision of this by-law by doing any act or thing that is prohibited, or by failing to do any act or thing that is required, is guilty of an offence and liable under summary conviction:
  - a) to pay a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not more than \$2,500.00; or
  - b) to be imprisoned for a period of not less than three days in default of payment of the fine within the time for payment allowed by the Court.
- 2) A Peace Officer or a By-Law Enforcement Officer employed by the Town of Fort Macleod may, in lieu of serving court process under the Provincial Offences Procedures Act for an alleged contravention of this Bylaw, serve upon the alleged offender a tag in a form prescribed by the Town specifying the nature of the alleged offense and stating that the Town will accept payment of \$100.00 at the Town Office within seven days of the date of service of the tag, in lieu of prosecution.

**SEVERANCE**

It is the intention of the Council of the Town of Fort Macleod that if a Court of competent jurisdiction declares any provision of this bylaw invalid for any reason then all other provisions of this bylaw shall remain valid and enforceable.

This bylaw shall come into full force and effect on August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 and will remain in effect until otherwise changed or altered by Council.
