TOWN OF FORT MACLEOD IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BYLAW NO. 1957

BEING a bylaw of the Town of Fort Macleod in the Province of Alberta, to amend Bylaw No. 1878, being the Union Cemetery Bylaw.

AND WHEREAS the purpose of proposed Bylaw No.1957 is to add sections on scattering grounds and a memorial bench/tree program.

AND WHEREAS the municipality must prepare an amending bylaw and provide for its consideration at a council meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000*, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of the Town of Fort Macleod in the Province of Alberta duly assembled does hereby enact the following:

1. That the following be added:

Section 16 - SCATTERING ASHES

- A. SCATTERING GROUNDS
 - a. Ashes must be scattered in the designated area (per Schedule "E")
 - b. No burial permit is required to scatter ashes.
 - c. Care must be taken to contain the ashes to the area (do not scatter in windy conditions).
 - d. The memorial wall is located in the scattering grounds (see Section 13).

Section 17 – MEMORIAL BENCH/TREE PROGRAM

- A. MEMORIAL BENCHES/TREES
 - a. The Town offers a memorial bench/tree program
 - b. Donations of Town approved trees and standardized memorial benches are welcomed and will be placed within the Memorial Bench area at the Union Cemetery or at the Town's choice of location.
