

What can go in my blue bin?

**Please Note - Everything needs to be dry,
cleaned, emptied and boxes flattened**

Everything can also be taken to the Bulk Recycling Depot



Aluminum pie plates/trays/foil
Soup cans, canned vegetables,
tuna cans, canned sauces
Clean tin take out food containers



Plastic beverage containers/cans
Plastic beverage bottles
Alcoholic beverage bottles/cans
Milk jugs/cartons
Juice containers



Corrugated cardboard, boxboard, cereal,
Granola, tissue boxes
Mail, books, magazines, cards, paper bags
Newspaper, phone books, flyers
Shoe boxes, toilet paper rolls



Yogurt, cottage cheese, sour cream
containers, clamshell containers
Ice cream buckets
Laundry jugs, dish soap bottle
Shampoo and lotion bottles (remove pump)

What can not go in my blue bin?

No aerosol or paint cans

No aluminum pots, frying pans or other metals

No glass

No shredded paper

No non-recyclable or soiled items

No styrofoam

No plastic bags

No tied bundles of paper

No motor oil or chemical containers

No plastic food wrap

No waxed cardboard

No paper towels/tissues

No disposable diapers or kitty litter

No plumbing pipe

No clothing or shoes

No furniture

No liquids

No ceramic/glass plates

No light bulbs/mirrors

No needles/syringes/medical supplies
