TOWN OF FORT MACLEOD PROVINCE OF ALBERTA BYLAW NO. 1966

Being a bylaw of the Town of Fort Macleod, in the Province of Alberta (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipality"), to repeal an inoperative, obsolete and otherwise ineffective Bylaw previously passed by the Municipality.

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 191 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c M-26, a council is authorized to repeal a bylaw;

AND WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Macleod enacted Bylaw 1032, to designate a portion of Town land between the Legion and Swinarton Block as a fire lane;

AND WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to repeal an inoperative, obsolete and otherwise ineffective Bylaw 1032;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Fort MacLeod, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. Short Title

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as "Bylaw No. 1966 repealing the fire lane Bylaw 1032."

2. Repeal of Bylaw

2.1 That Bylaw 1032 is hereby repealed.

3. Severability

3.1 If any portion of this Bylaw is declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the remainder of the Bylaw is deemed valid.

4. Enactment

4.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect when it has received third reading and has been duly signed.
