Town of Fort Macleod In the Province of Alberta

BYLAW NO. 1924

BEING a bylaw of the Town of Fort Mcleod in the Province of Alberta, to amend Bylaw No. 1837, being the Fort Macleod Traffic Bylaw.

WHEREAS the Town of Fort Macleod Council has been requested to amend defitnitions contained with Bylaw 1837;

AND WHEREAS the purpose of proposed Bylaw No. 1924 is to amend the definition of "Peace Officer" and remove the definition of "Bylaw Officer";

AND WHEREAS the municipality must prepare an amending bylaw and provide to Council for consideration.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000*, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of the Town of Fort Macleod in the Province of Alberta duly assembled does hereby enact the following:

- 1. That, Section 2. DEFINITIONS: 2.9 "Bylaw Officer: be hereby removed from Bylaw 1837.
- 2. and Further that, Section 2. DEFINITIONS 2.34 "Peace Officer" be amended to read the following:

"Peace Officer" means any member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, a sworn member of a municipal police service, or a Bylaw Enforcement Officer.

- 3. Bylaw No.1837 is hereby amended and consolidated.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into effect upon third and final reading and has been duly signed.
