1 Introduction

The Town of Fort Macleod is requesting quotations from individuals or contractors with experience in road construction to pave the gravel section of a municipal road in Fort Macleod.

The Town encourages contractors to seek efficiencies by combining several road and asphalt jobs which will be announced concurrently. Opportunities to reduce mob, waste, and scheduling costs will be considered when awarding individual contracts.

1. Interested parties must have proof of liability insurance, registered with WCB Alberta, hold a valid Town of Fort Macleod Business License, and detailed information on criteria for payment
2. The Town of Fort Macleod reserves the right to reject any and all bids
3. The Town of Fort Macleod has the right to select the proposal that best satisfies its interests and not necessarily on the basis of price or any other single factor
4. The town will not be liable for any additional work or damages directly attributed to neglect or poor workmanship of the prime contractor or any of their subcontractors

2 Scope

The Town of Fort Macleod will require the successful party to:

- Self-Assess the location and condition of the current road, and suggest any efficiency for the course of work
- Coordinate all traffic controls, road closures, and communicate with the town for resident awareness
- Manage all equipment as well as worker safety and incident investigations
- Prepare base structure for asphalt according to City of Lethbridge Design Standards for an Industrial Road
- Manage all dust controls during construction activities

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- Adjustments to heights of manholes and/or main valves present on this stretch of road
- Install asphalt according to City of Lethbridge Design Standards for an Industrial Road
- Mob and Demob – comment on efficiencies with other open tenders

3 Schedule

The Town of Fort Macleod will require an estimated schedule of procurement, execution and finishing. The successful party will coordinate:

- Site inspections to ensure understanding of the details of the bid
- Highlight any material deliveries delays
- Efficient coordination of multiple potential tenders in town
- Traffic controls
- Work Execution

4 Details

4.1 Scope:

- Traffic and dust control
- Surface area is ~8m wide roadway on 8th Ave starting just south of 12th street down to 9th Street
 - ~8m wide X 260m long
 - ~2,100m²
- Preparation of the base
 - Controlling the profile to shed water to east and west ditches, 2% slope
 - Adding material as needed to meet City of Lethbridge minimum roadway paving requirements for an Industrial Road
 - Final grade and compaction
- Tie-in to 12th Street asphalt
- Adjustments and risers to be added to manholes and main valves as required
 - Four main valves
 - Three manholes

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- Installation of asphalt
 - Asphalt must meet City of Lethbridge minimum roadway standards for an Industrial Road
 - 100mm Type II Asphalt Base Course
 - 60mm Type I Asphalt Surface
- Cleanup and Demob

4.2 City of Lethbridge Minimum Roadway Pavement Requirements:

6.16 MINIMUM ROADWAY PAVEMENT REQUIREMENTS

The following table outlines the minimum materials required for the pavement structures of roadways for the City of Lethbridge:
