TOWN OF FORT MACLEOD IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA BYLAW NO. 2014

BEING a bylaw of the Town of Fort Macleod in the Province of Alberta, to amend Bylaw No. 1985, being the Union Cemetery Bylaw.

WHEREAS the municipal council wishes, by way of this bylaw, to add niche costs for the new 48-unit columbarium and to allow for expedited interments at a higher rate.

AND WHEREAS the purpose of Bylaw No. 2014 is to add Section 3.d.ii under Part V Burials, Interments, Inurnments & Disinterments regarding expedited interments and to add a new fee for the 48-unit columbarium to Schedule B of the Union Cemetery bylaw.

AND WHEREAS the municipality must prepare an amending bylaw and provide for its consideration at a public hearing.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, the Council of the Town of Fort Macleod in the Province of Alberta duly assembled does hereby enact the following:

- That Section 3.d.ii be added under Part V Burials, Interments, Inurnments & Disinterments, stating the following:
 - 3.d.ii Any approval for interment requests (with less than the minimum timelines noted in 3.d.i above) will be at the discretion of the Supervisor. If a shorter interment timeline is accommodated, it will be charged out at 1.5 times the interment fees stated in Schedule B.
- 2. That Schedule B "Fees and Charges" be amended to include the following under Burial Rights:

- 3. Bylaw No. 1985, being the Union Cemetery, is hereby amended and consolidated.
- 4. This bylaw comes into effect upon the third and final reading hereof.
