Providing timely and accurate customer service is essential to facilitate all aspects of development and planning. The Development Officer is responsible for the planning requirements of customers including interpretation and application of land use bylaws, processing of development permits and providing information relating to subdivision applications through the Oldman River Regional Services Commissions Planner (ORRSC).

Whether you are considering developing or subdividing a property, including lot grading, filling, renovating, or operating a home business, the permitting process helps assure your proposed project meets the Towns bylaws, statutory plans, provincial codes and standards and the expectations of neighbours.
